WHEREAS, the PDIP CY 2020-2022 was already approved and endorsed to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan by the Provincial Development Council (PDC) thru PDC Resolution No. 4, series of 2019, but during the technical budget review conducted by the Local Finance Committee it was recommended that the projected income and expenditure will be increased to support the requirement of additional funding for Maintenance and Other Expenses (MOOE) particularly the requirement of the three (3) Provincial Hospitals and some adjustments in the statutory and mandatory obligations of the province;

WHEREAS, the updated PDIP includes PPAs that can be funded from local sources or from funds that can be generated from the national government or foreign grants and aids;

WHEREAS, after thorough deliberation the PDC-Executive Committee (PDC-Execom) deems that the CY 2020-2022 PDIP contains programs and projects which contributes to the localization of the Sustainable Development Goals, aligns with the Philippine Development Plan 2017-2022 and supports the attainment of the development agenda of the province;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved that the PDC-Executive Committee (PDC-Execom) approve and endorse the Provincial Development Investment Program (PDIP) CY 2020-2022 to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for their consideration and appropriate action;

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I. RATIONALE

This three-year Provincial Development Investment Program (PDIP) edition covers the period 2020-2022. It is the principal instrument that implements the Provincial Development and Physical Framework Plan (PDPFP) and the Executive and Legislative Agenda (ELA) of Davao del Norte. As it links the budget with the development priorities, it is the fulfillment of the mandate of the provincial government to ensure that "local budgets shall operationalize local development plans (Section 305i, RA7160)". This document contains the prioritized programs, projects and activities (PPAs) supportive of the continuing development agenda of the current administration. It describes how the PPAs are to be realized - financed through available local resources or through the national government and foreign grants and aids. Thus, more than just an extensive list of PPAs, the 2020-2022 PDIP is the document which guarantees that the provincial government invested in making significant positive changes in the lives of every Dabaonon.

The PDIP formalizes and ranks PPAs identified in the PDPFP, and matches the prioritized project list with the investment financing capacity of the province in an iterative manner. It needs to be updated because:

- a) It is imperative that the development investment portfolio of the province remains responsive to the development needs of its people;
- b) PDIP allocations change overtime as:
 - Anticipated funding may not have materialized
 - Emergencies and unanticipated circumstances may have resulted in allocating financial resources to projects not listed in the PDIP;
 - New development investment needs may have to be identified

This updated PDIP takes into consideration the changing field and financing conditions and includes new project requests arising from changes/adjustments because of the unforeseen circumstances mentioned above. The updating process gives the provincial investment programming-budgeting process a multi-year perspective and essentially shortens the required pre-budget activities.

II. PDIP POLICIES

- a. Programs, Projects and Activities (PPAs) are supportive of the development objectives set out in the PDPFP;
- b. PPAs implemented by phase should be given priority for completion;
- c. PPAs that cannot be funded by local funds may be sourced out from national government, NGAs, Grants, ODA, private participation or through borrowings;
- d. Co-sharing of projects cost with LGUs shall be encouraged;

- e. 20% Development Fund shall be used strictly in development projects and programs enumerated in DILG-DBM Joint Memorandum Circular (JMC) No. 2017-1 dated February 22, 2017;
- f. Participation of the private sector will be encouraged in the identification and implementation of cost-effective and cost-efficient public investments, programs and projects;
- g. PPAs that will encourage women's participation and human capital formation shall be promoted for globally competitive manpower;
- h. Regular programs, projects and activities shall no longer be subjected to PDIP prioritization process.

III. SDG-LINKED DEVELOPMENT AGENDA

One of the major developments that had to be taken into consideration in the updating of this PDIP is the birth of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development. It lists 17 integrated and indivisible goals which balance the three dimensions of sustainable development: the economic, social and environmental. All countries and all stakeholders, acting in collaborative partnership, will implement this agenda summarized into five (5) key elements: People, Prosperity, Planet, Peace and Partnership.

While implementation of the 2030 Agenda occurs primarily at the national level, SDG achievement depends strongly on progress made at the local level. Recognizing the important role of the provincial government in the achievement of the SDG milestones and targets, the priority programs, projects and activities listed in this updated PDIP is anchored on the localization of the 17 Sustainable Development Goals.

PEOPLE (KATAWHAN)













Davao del Norte will adopt and expand its social protection systems to address poverty bearing in mind that poverty is often determined by social economic status, gender, ethnicity and geography. This PDIP lists investments in agriculture to end hunger, food insecurity and malnutrition, improve health systems for mothers and children and invest in high infectious and non-communicable diseases avoidance. Investments in inclusive and equitable education and gender equality and the empowerment of women and girls through vigorous efforts including legal frameworks are also pursued.

PROSPERITY (KAUSWAGAN)











Economic development is still a key component in Davao del Norte's thrusts. We believe that the key to prosperity is building greener and sustainable communities in the midst of urbanization. This PDIP will support SDG Goals 7-11 by identifying PPAs that:

- 1. promote efficient, affordable and clean energy for all;
- 2. reduce inequalities in the economic sector and provide decent work and economic growth for all, and;
- 3. advocate infrastructure, industry and social innovation.

PLANET (KINAIYAHAN)









Even while we pursue economic development, Davao del Norte shall endeavor to build a better future for the next generation by sustaining significant interventions and engaging the community in managing its forest, watershed areas, coastal marine ecosystems, as well as, the urban landscape. Deforestation, pollution, greenhouse gas emissions, climate change, globalization and other factors of our modern daily life are wiping out species and damaging ecosystems at unprecedented rates. Davao del Norte is determined to contribute in protecting the planet from degradation by investing in PPAs

that focuses on sustainable consumption and production, sustainably managing our natural resources and taking urgent action on climate change.

PEACE (KALINAW)



Davao del Norte acknowledges that without peace, justice and strong institutions, there can be no hope for sustainable development. As violence is bred by exclusion and isolation, Davao del Norte is committed to continue best practices and install crucial reforms that value the principles of inclusivity, participation, transparency and accountability. The ONE TEAM, ONE DAVNOR stance of the province declares the commitment of all cities and municipalities to work as one to achieve its vision. With this PDIP, investments that improve access to technology and knowledge and subsequently foster innovation are pursued.

All of the 17 Goals and 169 targets of the SDG are localized in the development agenda of the province for the next three years dubbed as KUYA GOB. As a guiding development framework, KUYA GOB maintains its welfare-driven mission but emphasizes the shift from profit to service-oriented goals. The components of the KUYA GOB Development Agenda are aligned with national and regional strategic priorities and integrate support mechanisms to ensure whole-of-government capacity. The achievement of the outcomes and impact-based targets of KUYA GOB will be measured against the approved Davao del Norte Results Matrices.

IV. PROJECTIONS IN REVENUES, EXPENDITURES AND INDEBTEDNESS

Projections in revenues and expenditures including indebtedness are presented in tables 1 and 2, respectively. The three-year projections cover the period 2020-2022. Although local revenues are increasing steadily, based on the projection, it can be observed from the table that the income of the province still relies heavily on the Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) share.

Projected income for the next three years has already reached the billion marks. For CY 2020, projected income is Php 2,128,290,198.00; CY 2021 is Php 2,131,535,000.00 and for CY 2022 the anticipated income is Php 2,232,912,000.00.

The amount for investment financing potential is determined by deducting the statutory and mandatory obligations to the projected total revenues and the SEF (Table 2). As in the income, these obligations are also increasing steadily with the loan amortization doubling in 2021.

V. INVESTMENT PROGRAMS, PROJECTS AND ACTIVITIES

Programs, Projects and activities that are prioritized for immediate funding from the local funds are presented in Table No. 3 with further details in Table No. 4. The Investment Program shows the costs of major programs under the four priority sectors for development viz:

PPAs for funding under the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund are also integrated as an essential element of this PDIP. These PPAs are expected to strengthen the capacity of the province to build disaster resilient communities and respond to calamities. They aptly cover four distinct yet mutually reinforcing thematic areas in disaster management in support to the attainment of the country's overall DRRM vision. The specific projects for the following four major programs are presented in Table No. 5.

- Disaster Prevention and Mitigation Program
- Disaster Preparedness Program
- Disaster Response Program
- Disaster Rehabilitation and Recovery Program

VI. OTHER SOURCES

As the priority projects with the biggest impact at optimum cost were considered for local funding, some development projects were considered for funding from Other Sources. The PPAs with funding requirements which cannot be accommodated in the local government funds are presented in Table Nos. 6 and 7. Most of these PPAs are big-ticket development projects, thus the only other option for funding would be from other agencies and donor institutions.

These PPAs support the following development areas:

- a) Regular PPAs for Supplemental Budget
- b) Public Infrastructure
- c) Environment Development
- d) Community and livelihood opportunities
- e) Land and Housing
- f) Health Development
- g) Agri-Aquaculture enhancement
- h) Tourism Development
- i) Public-Private Partnership

Regular PPAs for Supplemental Budget are those proposed budgetary increase in specific items/activities in the regular PPAs which were deferred considering the limited projected available local funds (Table No. 7-A). These proposed increases arising from expansion of project scope, addition of project beneficiaries or provision of buffer for inflation are deemed as not urgent but still necessary thus it will be funded should there be available supplemental budget.

The Public Infrastructure projects proposed for funding under other sources are all in line with national development direction and are supportive of the Build, Build, Build Project of the National Government. Primary of which is the Samal Island-Davao City (SIDC) Bridge Connector Project with feasibility studies currently being undertaken. This mega project will improve accessibility of one of Davao del Norte's prime tourism destination – the Island Garden City of Samal. Other projects along

this line include the Tourism Road Infrastructure project (TRIP), Roads Leveraging Linkages on Trade and Industry (ROLL-IT), Philippine Rural Development Program (PRDP), Farm-to-Market Road Development Program (FMRDP), Conditional Matching Grant for Provinces (CMGP), Payapa at Masaganang Pamayanan (PAMANA). All of these are aimed at enhancing inter and intra connectivity and consequently improving trade and commerce.

The rest of the other projects were proposed to resolve major concerns in the various development areas, further improve delivery of basic services and address future needs. The Tagum-Libuganon Riverbasin (TLRB) Masterplan, for instance, introduces a watershed management approach in addressing recurring environmental problems in the province. The investments proposed in the TLRB Masterplan are thus adopted in this PDIP for funding from the Department of Public Works and National Highways and the Department of Environment and Natural Resources Office.
